

Go Kart Attendant

The purpose of the Go Kart Attendant is to ensure the safety of our customers and maintain the integrity of our equipment by enforcing all posted safety rules.

The Go Kart Attendant must be able to communicate (written and verbal) in English.

The Go Kart Attendant may be required to do the following:

- Communicate information pertaining to all attractions to our customers
- Straighten tires around the perimeter of the track
- Clean up garbage and other debris from around the track and field
- Communicate via a 2-way radio
- Alert management to disorderly customers
- Take tickets
- Direct customers to correct Go Kart
- Ensure that the appropriate person is driving the Double Seat Go Kart
- Ensure that all seatbelts are fastened
- Tell customers the rules before the start of the ride
- Start the ride
- Remind customers the rules throughout the ride
- Assist customers whose Go Karts have become stuck
- Park Go Karts at the end of the ride
- Direct customers to the ride exit
- Prepare Go Karts for operation
- Operate the Shut-Off System
- Tell Mechanic if something is wrong with a Go Kart

Typical Working Conditions

The Go Kart Attendant works outside in the elements. This means that the Go Kart Attendant may be exposed to heat (upwards of 100 degree Fahrenheit) and cold.

Go Kart Attendants are expected to stand for the duration of the shift.

Go Kart Attendants will be exposed to a high level of noise.

The Go Kart Attendant must be at least 16 years old.

Arcade & Attraction Attendant

The purpose of the Arcade & Attraction Attendant is to be the first point of contact for all customers, completing transactions with customers via our cash registers and our redemption counter, ensuring the safety of our customers, and the integrity of our equipment by enforcing all safety rules at the Bumper Boats and Miniature Golf Courses. The Arcade & Attraction Attendant may be required to fill in on Kiddie Karts.

The Arcade & Attraction Attendant must be able to communicate (both written and verbal) in English.

The Arcade & Attraction Attendant may be required to do the following:

Arcade

- Communicate information about all the attractions to customers
- Complete monetary transactions as a cashier
- Help customers pick out prizes at our redemption counter
- Explain to customers the swipe card system
- Maintain the cleanliness of the Arcade and surrounding area
- Assist customers in the operation of the games
- Communicate via a 2-way Radio
- Inform Management of disorderly customers
- Inform Management of any issues with the games or other machines

Bumper Boats

- Take tickets for the ride
- Ensure that customers meet the age and height requirement
- Help customers in and out of the Bumper Boats, which may include bending and leaning
- Inform customers of the proper use of the Bumper Boats
- Start the ride
- Maintain the cleanliness of the Bumper Boat pool by scooping debris from the pool and maintain the cleanliness of the surrounding area by picking up garbage and other debris
- Prepare the Bumper Boats for rides by ensuring that there are the proper number of Bumper Boats charged and that the level of the charge is sufficient for the day
- Communicate via 2-Way Radio
- Inform Management of any issues with the Bumper Boats
- Inform Management of any disorderly customers

Miniature Golf

- Take tickets for the game
- Hand out and collect Miniature Golf equipment, such as golf putters and golf balls

- Ensure that customers follow the safety rules posted on the miniature golf stand
- Ensure that all equipment is returned to the Miniature Golf stand
- Maintain the cleanliness of the Miniature Golf courses and the ponds by the scooping debris from the ponds and picking up garbage from the ground
- Assist the Facility Maintenance Crew by pulling weeds and other unwanted plant growth

Typical Working Conditions

The Arcade & Attraction Attendant works some shifts indoors and some shifts outdoors. This means that the Arcade & Attraction Attendant may be exposed to heat (upwards of 100 degree Fahrenheit) and cold.

Arcade & Attraction Attendants may sit during the shift when working at an outdoor attraction, but are expected to stand to help customers when needed, especially at the Bumper Boats.

The Arcade & Attraction Attendants will be exposed to high volumes and flashing lights.

The Arcade & Attraction Attendant must be at least 16 years old.

Concession Attendant

The purpose of the Concession Attendant is to provide our customers with food and refreshments in a timely manner, while maintaining the integrity of our equipment.

The Concession Attendant must be able to communicate (both written and verbal) in English.

The Concession Attendant may be required to do the following:

- Communicate information about all of the attractions to our customers
- Operate a cash register
- Prepare food using equipment such as a deep fryer, hot dog warmer, etc.
- Maintain cleanliness inside the Concession Trailer to meet all applicable health codes
- Maintain cleanliness outside the Concession Trailer and surrounding area
- Inform Management of disorderly customers
- Inform Management when inventory of items is running low
- Communicate via a 2-way radio

Typical Work Conditions

The Concession Attendant will work primarily in the Concession Trailer, but may be required to work at extra events that put them outdoors.

Air conditioning and heat are present in the Concession Trailer, but the Concession Attendant may be exposed to heat in excess of 80 degrees Fahrenheit, and may be exposed to colder conditions in the cooler months.

The Concession Attendant must be at least 18 years of age.

Facility Maintenance

The Facility Maintenance team serves a vital role at Kart Kountry. They provide our customers with a clean, safe, and beautiful park.

The Facility Maintenance Team must be able to communicate (both written and verbal) in English.

Typical Duties:

- Routine grounds maintenance, including weeding, mowing, trash collection and pick up, gardening, etc.
- Visual facelift, including sanding, painting, staining, outdoor carpeting, etc.
- General maintenance duties, including repairing fencing and netting, concreting loose poles and stands, replacing ropes, etc.
- Other duties as assigned by management

Requirements:

- Must be at least 18 years old
- Must have open availability to include early mornings, late nights, week days, weekends, and holidays
- Must be able to work independently or in a team
- Must demonstrate high levels of dependability, honesty, and dedication

Desirables:

- One year maintenance experience in the entertainment industry
- First Aid/CPR certification

Work Conditions:

Members of the Facility Maintenance team regularly work outdoors in all weather. This means that the Facility Maintenance technician can expect to be exposed to extreme heat (in excess of 100 degrees Fahrenheit) and cold.
